United Youth Corps and Good Works will once again be co-sponsoring a project in Guatemala! This project will take place at the Eagle's Nest Orphanage from Dec. 25, 2016, until Jan. 8, 2017. Plans are being made to have an event with the Guatemalan brethren's children prior to going to Eagle's Nest Orphanage.

The children at Eagle's Nest Orphanage thrive on receiving individual attention from loving adults. Therefore the Youth Corps Team's primary goal will be to spend time each day showing the children love, affection and building relationships.

The team will conduct fun activities; including music, sports, English and Bible lessons, outdoor games, swimming, and art projects. Team members will also spend time improving the Eagle's Nest orphanage through a work project.

Eagle's Nest encourages the groups to craft the project based on the strengths of the volunteers. Other secondary objectives include helping contribute to the maintenance of the campus, provide entertainment, or help with serving meals to local children in need.

We are seeking ten individuals who are passionate about working with children, showing them love and affection and are willing to stretch outside of their comfort zone. Once selected, applicants will be involved with planning activities for the project. These Youth Corps participants will join five young adults from Guatemala to work together at Eagle's Nest orphanage. Team members should be able to maintain a positive attitude when faced with uncomfortable conditions, and be able to adapt to a changing schedule. Proficiency in the Spanish language is extremely helpful.

COST:

Room, board and ground transportation to and from the orphanage will be provided by Good Works. Participants are expected to provide their airfare costs (costs will vary depending on location). Scholarships may be made available based on need.
